

Board of Commissioners of Island County

April Session, 1853. First Day

Election Precincts.

A precinct for election purposes shall include all that portion of Island County lying south of Holmes Harbor, to be named "Skaget Head, Precinct"; the house of Bailly shall be the place of holding elections in said precinct.

All that portion of Island County lying north of Reception Passage shall constitute an election precinct to be called "<sup>Dunroop</sup> ~~both~~ Precinct", and the house of Parrot shall be the place of holding elections.

The remainder of Island County shall constitute "Lower Precincts", and the place of holding elections shall be the house of R. H. Madaley.

Place of holding Courts.

With further order, the house of John Alexander in Cowland, is appointed the place of holding the courts in this county.
