

Board of Commissioners of Island County, Extra Session of August, 1853. First Day

Cleveland, Monday,
August 1st, 1853.

The board of commissioners of Island County met in extra session in pursuance to notice given according to law, on Monday the first day of August, A.D. 1853, at the house of John Alexander in Cleveland; present John Alexander, John Crockett, and Samuel H. Howe, commissioners, Hugh Crockett, sheriff, and R. W. Sandale, Auditor and Clerk of Island County.

Assessor of Island County for 1853.

There having been no general election held on the first Monday of June last, and consequently no assessor elected for this county for the year 1853, the board hereby appoints and constitutes ~~Samuel H. Howe~~ B. Morse, assessor of Island County for the year 1853, who shall qualify, according to law.

Justices of the Peace

The board appoints John Davis a justice of the peace in the room, and stead of Asaue M. Eby, who was appointed, to serve till June, 1853; and also, Thomas Hattie, an additional justice of the peace for Island County, to hold office till his successor is qualified.
