Roads from Coveland to N. E. corner of J. N. Eby's claim

Now come H. Shaw, J. N. Eby, & S. Crockett, appointed view-  
ers on a road from Coveland to the N. E. corner of J. N. Eby's claim  
and reports in writing that they have viewed out and estab-  
lished a road commencing at the south end of Beach  
street in Coveland, and running around the head of  
Pennis Cove, until it leaves its shores, in a south easterly  
direction to the North east corner of the claim of J. N.  
Eby; which road, as reported, is confirmed and estab-  
lished as a county road; H. Shaw is appointed supervisor  
of said road, and he is authorized and required to  
work all the hands on both sides of Pennis Cove two  
days in opening and working said road.
