

Record of the Board of Commissioners of Island County.

Monday, December 5th, 1853.

The Board of Commissioners of Island County met, pursuant to law in Cleveland, on Monday the 5th day of December, 1853. Present, John Crockett and Samuel D. Howe, county commissioners, Hugh Crockett, Sheriff, and A. H. Sandstead, Auditor, &c. &c. clerk of the board of commissioners: the session was opened by public proclamation.

Blank-Books for County Offices.

The clerk of this board now brings forward 17 quires of light bound books for the use of the County Offices, in execution of the order of last session of this board, appropriating \$10 for that purpose.

Justice of the Peace in Cleveland Precinct.

Nathaniel D. Hill is appointed by the board a justice of the peace for Island County in Cleveland precinct in place of John Davis, who refuses to qualify; and who will serve till his successor is elected & qualified.

Compensation for this session, &c.

Ordered, That John Crockett, he and he is hereby allowed the sum of nine dollars in full for his services as county commissioner since the organization of the county, to include this session.

Ordered, That S. D. Howe be allowed three dollars for one day's attendance at this session.
