Ordered, That R. W. Lamsdale be and he is hereby allowed as follows; - \$9.50 for two Tax duplicates; \$2.50 for 100 words last session; - 50cts - 5 filings; - 70cts for 7 ho. warrants; - \$1.00 for 2 appointments issued - 2 per accounts filed. Total, \$14.70 (\$50 for certificates to be seen)

Compensation to Sheriff.

Ordered, That Hugh Crockett, Sheriff, be and he is hereby allowed \$7.50 as follows: for one day's attendance on District Court April term 1853; calling courts, calling 2 persons: one day's attendance the session.

Auditor's Fees at this Session.

Ordered, That R. W. Lamsdale, Co. Auditor be and he is hereby allowed the following fees: For this day \$3.00 on each - 500 words - 1.25 - 2 filings - 20cts. 5 ho. warrants. 50cts. one appointment 50cts., out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
