

Records of the Board of Commissioners

First Day

Monday, July 3^d, 1854.

The Board of Commissioners of Island County, in Washington Territory, met according to law in Cleveland at 10 o'clock A.M. on Monday, July the first Monday, the 3^d day of July, 1854;

Present, John Alexander and John Crockett appointed County Commissioners of Island County by the Legislative Assembly of Washington Territory, Hugh Crockett, appointed Sheriff of said county, and R. H. Sandale, appointed Auditor of said county.

The said John Alexander and John Crockett are duly sworn and certify of their oaths according to law, and the said R. H. Sandale is duly sworn, his bond approved & certified of his oaths, according to law. And now comes Isaac B. Power appointed a county commissioner by the Legislative Assembly and is sworn into office according to law; and the said Hugh Crockett appointed Sheriff as aforesaid, gives bond and is sworn into office according to law.

Road from J. N. Eby's claim to J. S. Smith's claim.

Now is presented the petition of J. S. Smith and seven others praying for the view of a county road from J. N. Eby's land claim to N. W. corner of J. S. Smith's land claim, which is read, and the board having considered the matter, do appoint R. S. Robinson, Humphrey Hill and J. W. Lyle to view a county road from the N. W. corner of J. N. Eby's land claim to the nearest and

best ground to the N. W. corner of J. S. Smith's land claim near Shode (was Point), and they, a majority of them, shall proceed to view said road on the 15th day of July next, and cheerfully to the next regular meeting of this board.

Road from Cleveland to R. C. Foy's land claim.

Now come R. H. Sandale & James Reilly a majority of the voters on the county road from Cleveland to R. C. Foy's land claim & fishing station and report as follows which is read according to law.
