Coveland Tuesday Jan 16th 1855

The Board of Commissioners of Island County met in Coveland. Pursuant to Public Notice put up according to Law, on Tuesday January sixteenth 1855, Present. Caleb Miller, and Jehiel Hall, County Commissioners; and J. J. Turner, clerk of the Board. The session was opened by Public Proclamation.

Appointment of County Commissioners  
The Board of Commissioners now appoints John Crockett a Commissioner of Island Co in place of the Commissioner who was elected at the annual Election and neglected to qualify according to Law. and the said John Crockett is duly sworn, and a certificate of his oath filed according to Law

The Board now appoints John Crockett, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners and he forthwith enters upon the duties of said chairman.

The Board proceeds to determine by lot. The Term of office for each member of the Board, which resulted as follows. Jehiel Hall of Tealip Precinct, and Caleb Miller of Oak Harbor Precinct, serve two years, and John Crockett of Coveland Precinct, serve one year.
