First Day Monday, March 5th, 1855.

The Board of Commissioners of Island County met pursuant to Law at Cowland on Monday the fifth Day of March A. D. 1855. Present Ans. - brickell, Caleb Miller, & Schiel Hall, Commissioners. J. J. Turner, Clerk. Board of Comrs and Jacob Smith, Sheriff. The session was opened By "Public proclamation."

Special Election Allowances.

3 Cowland Precinct

Ordered by the Board of Commissioners that, Samuel Sibley, John Alexander, and B. S. Bollen, be and they are hereby each allowed out of any moneys in the County Treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of three dollars, for one day services each, as Judges of Election in Cowland precinct.

Ordered, that Robt C. Hill, and Thomas Cooney, be and they are hereby each allowed the sum of three dollars for one days services as clerks of Election, in the above named precinct.

3 Oak Harbor Precinct

Ordered, that Samuel Walker, ~~and~~ M. Ford, and Ulrich Friend, be and they are hereby allowed the sum of three dollars each for one days services as Judges of Election, in Oak Harbor precinct, out of any moneys in the County Treasury, not otherwise appropriated.

And, that, Charles Miller, and G. M. Sumner, be and they are hereby allowed the sum of three dollars each for one days services as clerks of the above Election.

- Sealup Precinct -

Ordered by the Board of Commissioners, that G. Barrington, John Gouldy, and N. W. Kauger, be and they are hereby allowed the sum of three dollars each, for one days services, as Judges of Election in Sealup precinct.

And that, R. Phillips, and S. D. Rowe, be and they are hereby allowed three dollars, each for one days service as clerks of the above named Election - out of any moneys in the County Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Cauvassing Election Returns and Transmitting

- Toll Books -

Ordered by the Board, that G. Barrington, be and he is hereby allowed the sum of three dollars and seventy five cents for carrying Toll from County Seat to Sealup 30 miles at 15 cents per mile. Twenty five miles.

And that S. D. Rowe, be and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$7.50 for Transmitting Toll Books from Sealup to County Seat 15 miles at 50 c per mile.

And it is further ordered that S. D. Rowe be and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$4.00 for cauassing Election Returns.

Ordered, that S. Walker, be and he is hereby allowed the sum four dollars & 50 c for Transmitting Toll Books from Oak Harbor, to County Seat 16 miles at 30 c per mile.
