The Board of Commissioners of Island County met pursuant to law in Island County on Monday the 4th day of June A.D. 1855. Present John D. Bell, John Bennett, Caleb Miller, County Commissioners and J. S. Turner, Clerk of the Board and Jacob Smith Sheriff, session opened by Public Proclamation -

Road from Loveland to Oak Harbor

Now is presented the report of the viewers appointed to view, locate, and alter the position of the County Road leading from Loveland to Oak Harbor, which is read according to law, and no objection being made, said report is adopted and said Road is confirmed according to the report of the Viewers as follows

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Island County N.T. Whereas we the undersigned were appointed by your Hon. Body Viewers to view an alteration in the County road leading from Jones Cove to Oak Harbor:-

Therefore we beg leave to report in compliance with an order issued by the Clerk of said Board. We attended to the duties of our appointment on the 17th da of March. A.D. 1855.

And we find an abbreviation in the distance by the New ~~Home~~ route of about one mile, and also by said alteration ~~it~~ it will avoid a rise of ground of about an hundred feet, and also a long and hole on Friar's ~~land~~ ~~land~~ Land held by us find the new route in every respect feasible

Setting down the bill in the rear of Sutton, and Barringtons, and bridging a brook near the Lane belonging to G. W. Sumner, will be at all the expense required at present.

We respectfully recommend its adoption believing it will be for the best interest of the County. We therefore submit it to your consideration
