First Day Monday Sept 5th

The Board of Commissioners of Island County met according to law in the barland. deland Co. M.S. on the first Monday, the 5th day of September, 1855. Present: S. W. Hall, Gold Miller, and Jacob Eby, Co. Commissioners and S. J. Turner, (Clerk Officer) Clerk

Appointment of chairman per Board of Co. Commissioners per Year 1855.

The Board now appoints Gold Miller, Chairman, and he thereupon enters upon the functions of said office.

Alteration of Road Districts No. 1 & 2.

The board now alters and establishes the Road Districts of Island Co., as follows to wit: Road District No. 1 shall include all that part of barland Precinct lying north of the head of a small lagoon or lake near the house of B. P. Boston, deceased, to a line N. West of Mrs. Andrew's Point - and that Road District No. 2 shall include all the remaining part of barland Precinct

Supervisors for Road Districts No. 1, 2 & 3.

The Board appoints S. W. Hall, Supervisor for Road District No. 1, in Oak Harbor Precinct

And Jacob Smith, Supervisor for Road District No. 2, and Geo. Alexander be the Supervisor for District No. 3. - and that they qualify and continue in office until the next annual election as prescribed by law regulating the election of said offices.

Bridge Appropriation

The Board hereby records an order by the board of Co. Commissioners at their usual session ~~on~~ in the first Monday Sept. 1855, which appropriated the sum for the building of a Bridge across Tidds Water Creek leading from barland barland.

Annual Election Allowances

The Board hereby orders that the usual clerks and judges of election in 1855, be allowed out of the Co. Treasury the following sums - as allowed by the Co. Auditor ~~to wit~~

ordered, by the board that Schiel Hoall, John Smith, and R. S. Bailey be and they are hereby allowed \$5.00 each for services as judges of election in barland Precinct

and that G. S. Philips, and R. S. Bailey be and they are hereby allowed \$5.00 for services as Clerks of Election in said Precinct.
