The Board of Commissioners of Island County met according to law in Cleveland Island Co. Ia. on the first Monday the 3rd day of December 1855.

Present Caleb Miller and Jacob Leiby Esq. Commissioners and Thos Conroy Deputy Clerk.

Ordered by the Board that a Bounty of three dollars (3.00) be and is hereby allowed to each and every individual who will kill or destroy each wolf in the vicinity of Island County, who will receive a certificate of the same from any Justice of the peace of said County.

Road from Camp + Alex Anders point to intersect a County Road from Cleveland to Smiths Landing. Now is presented the petition of Thos Couper and eleven other residents hereinafter of Island County praying to lay off a County Road commencing at Pans Cove at a point on said Cove at the corner of the land claim of John Alex Anders and to apt Thos Couper therein in a southerly direction along the line dividing said land to the water. Section of a County road from Cleveland to Smiths Landing, and said petition herein has been read according

to Law, and no objection having been made, it is ordered by the Board of Commissioners that Jacob Leiby John Alex Anders Esq, and Robert C Miller be and are hereby appointed to view and locate said Road as prayed for, by said petition upon the best and most profitable ground and that they or a majority of them report to the Board at its next session.

Ordered by the Board that G. B. Bann be and is hereby allowed \$7.50 for Cony. post North, from County Court to In Lake precinct, 50 miles at 15¢ of mile, the rest being received at proper session.

Ordered by the Board that D. H. St. Landon now under now in possession of J. J. Sumner be and is hereby rented from the present time at the rate of one dollar per month for the use of County purposes.

Ordered by the Board that J. J. Sumner County Auditor be and he is hereby allowed \$28.30 for services and expenses from September session to Dec. session of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.
