First Day  
January Jan 1st 56

The Board of County Commissioners  
of Island County met on Tuesday pursuant  
to the adjournment of the 1st day of Jan 1st  
1856 according to Law at one o'clock  
Island County Mr. Secretary, Present  
Lelet Miller and Jacob Leby  
County Commissioners and  
Clancy Deputy County Auditor

Revenue for 1856

Now comes Samuel Walker Assessor  
for Island County for 1856 and makes  
return of his assessment of persons and  
property in Island County and the  
Board having reviewed and the Roll  
it is ordered to be filed and the  
proper Duplicates to be made out,  
one mill is assessed on each one hundred  
dollars for Sanitorial purposes, two  
mills for school purposes and four  
mills for County purposes and one  
dollar upon each taxable Poll

Ordered by the Board that  
Clancy Deputy County Auditor  
be and he is hereby allowed the sum  
of eight dollars and seventy seven cents  
(8.77) for services and expenses from Dec  
session 1855 to Jan session 1856 and  
for out (1.50) of settlement of his a/c making  
nine dollars and 27 cents (9.27)

out of any money remaining in the  
Treasury not otherwise appropriated

The Board having received the  
account of the Assessor for 1856, he  
is allowed \$62.50 for 12 1/2 days salary  
Island County and 75 cts for paper  
furnished of duplicate assessments Roll  
Total amount allowed of 63.25 out  
of any money remaining in the Treasury  
not otherwise appropriated

Ordered by the Board that  
Samuel Walker Assessor be and  
he is hereby allowed the sum of  
\$10.00 for taking the Census of the  
County for the year 1856, out of  
any money remaining in the Treasury  
not otherwise appropriated

Ordered by the Board that  
for the same reason he is hereby allowed  
\$25.00 of services as Probate Judge  
for Island County, from Dec 1855  
to Jan 1856 as of 1st filed, out of any  
money remaining in the Treasury  
not otherwise appropriated
