Ordered By the Board that
the Journal known as Salsipis Journal,
be again in booky abolished and that
it be now attached to one land
Journal for all future coming papers

Ordered By the Board that
Caleb Miller and Jacob Wiley be
and they are hereby allowed the sum
of three dollars (\$3.00) each for the
days service as County Commissioners
and Caleb Miller two dollars (\$2.00)
and Jacob Wiley forty cents (.40) as
mileage out of any moneys remaining
in the treasury

and it is further ordered
by the Board that John C. Arney
be and he is hereby allowed (as deputy
County Auditor) the sum of 3 dollars for
the days service as Clerk and \$1.25
for receiving 500 words and \$0.50 for
attendant of Ostrale badge. making total
of \$4.75 out of and moneys
remaining in the Treasury not
otherwise appropriated
