First day 1st September 1856

The Board of County Commissioners of Island County met according to Law in Casland Hall on Monday the first day of September A. D. 1856 Present Jacob C. By and John B. Pown County Commissioners and John C. Leamy County Auditor.

Appointment of Sheriff Ordered by the Board that Alfred M. Miller be and he is hereby appointed Sheriff of Island County in room of H. W. Allen who was elected at the last annual election but failed to qualify and that the clerk notify him of such appointment.

Election Allowances

Ordered by the Board that John S. By, J. B. Pown and Samuel Crockett be and they are hereby allowed three dollars each (\$3.00) for services as judges of election and also that John C. Leamy be allowed three dollars each (\$3.00) as clerk of election of Island County out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

First day Continued

Ordered by the Board that J. J. Linn be and that he is hereby allowed \$3.00 each for one days attendance concerning election out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

And it is further ordered by the Board that J. J. Linn be allowed three \$3.00 for making out abstract of the votes cast for County and Territorial offices in duplicate 1200 words out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Ordered by the Board that John C. Leamy County Auditor be and he is hereby allowed \$12.32 1/2 for dinner and supplies for Island County out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Ordered by the Board that Jacob C. By and John B. Pown be allowed \$5.00 each for the days service as County Commissioners and Jacob C. By be allowed 40¢ mileage and J. B. Pown 30¢ mileage to & from the County seat to place of residence out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.
