1st Dec 1856

The Board of County Commissioners of Island County met according to law at Cleveland Island County on Monday the first day of December 1856 Present. Robert Miller, and Isaac B. Power County Commissioners and Thomas Creamer County Auditor.

Appointment of Chairman of Board of County Commissioners for the year 1856-1857

The Board now Appoints Robert Miller Chairman and he thereupon enters upon the duties of said office

Appointment of Justice of the Peace for Cleveland Precinct Island County

Ordered by the Board that Winfield S. Ely be and he is hereby appointed Justice of the Peace for Cleveland Precinct Island County.

Allowances

Ordered by the Board that Jacob Smith Sheriff be and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$33.00 for services rendered the District Court of Island County Oct Term 1856 and a further sum of \$15.00 for services rendered as Sheriff to the District Court

Ordered by the Board that Mr Creamer County Auditor be and he is hereby allowed \$3.75 for services & supplies and for left to be drawn out of any moneys remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Ordered by the Board that Mr Creamer County Auditor be and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$2.00 for Office Rent out of any moneys remaining in Treasury not otherwise appropriated. also allowing for office use in Feb that was found.

Ordered by the Board that Robert Miller, Jacob Ely and Isaac B. Power the sum of \$3.00 each for this days services as County Commissioners and Robert Miller \$2.00 mileage, Jacob Ely 409 mileage and Isaac Power 309 mileage out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated

And it is further Ordered by the Board that Thomas Creamer County Auditor be and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$3.00 for this days services as clerk of the Board
