First day  
2<sup>d</sup> March 1857

The Board of County Commissioners of Island County met according to their usual custom on Monday the 2<sup>d</sup> day of March A.D. 1857. Present Caleb Miller, Jacob E. Gay and J. P. Bowen County Commissioners and Thomas Keramey County Auditor.

Final settlement with the County Treasurer and Collector for fiscal year ending June 11. A.D. 1856.

On final settlement with the Collector and Treasurer of Island County the Board find the amount collected and paid in by the Collector for the year A.D. 1856 to be \$433.854 and the amount of delinquents \$60.694 and it is therefore credited by the Board for the amount returned delinquent, and the amount paid over in Order and Justicial fund to be \$323.26 and the cost of School funds on hand including the Balance remaining on hand for the fiscal year ending June 1854, to be \$228.03 and the amount of County Orders issued and cancelled by the Board. It is therefore ordered by the Board that the County Auditor make out and set up according to Law a

Resolved by the Board to Dr. Show he and he is hereby appointed assessor for Island County for the year 1857 in the stead of Samuel Walker who has left the County and that the Clerk notify J. D. Show forthwith and have him qualify according to Law and provide forthwith to assess the County for the fiscal year A.D. 1857.
