The Board of County Commissioners of Island County met at Coulter's according to Law on Monday the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 1857. Present W. A. Miller, Jacob Eby and Isaac Brown County Commissioners and F. W. Leary County Auditor

Final settlement with the County Treasurer for the fiscal year 1857.

On final settlement with the Treasurer and Collector for the fiscal 1857. The Board finds the amt collected and paid in by said Treasurer to be \$489.48 and the amount of delinquent returned by the Board to be \$30.20 which is ordered by the Board to be credited as returned delinquent. And the amt reimbursed by the Treasurer to be \$308.70 and the amt of School fund collected to be \$120.94 and the Judicial Tax to be \$59.79. Total collected \$1009.41

Revenue for 1857

Now Comes W. A. Miller & Eby assessor for Island County for 1857 and makes return of his assessment of persons and property in Island County and the Board having examined and corrected the roll it is ordered to be filed and the proper duplicates to be made out one mill is assessed for Territorial purposes, three mills for School purposes one mill for the Court fund and three mills for County purposes

The Board having received the account of the assessor for 1857 he is allowed the sum of five dollars (\$5.00) for eight days services attending Island County out of any monies remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated
