Ordered by the Board that James Burgh be and he is hereby appointed Road supervisor for Case Harbour District and that he qualify according to Law

Ordered by the Board that Caleb Miller be and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$5.00. Jacob the sum of \$3.30 and J. B. Down the sum of \$3.25 for one days services and mileage as County Commissioners at this present session out of any moneys remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated

Ordered by the Board that the County Auditor be and he is hereby allowed \$3.00 for this day services as Clerk and the further sum of \$1.75 for recording 700 words. Total allowance \$4.75 out of any moneys remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated
