The Board of County Commissioners of Island County met at Cove Land in said County according to Law on Monday the 7th day of Sept A.D. 1857. Present Jacob Ely and J. B. Powers County Commissioners and F. W. Cramm County Auditor

Appointments of Probate Judge

The Board of Commissioners now in session do appoint Samuel D. Edlow as Probate Judge in and for the County of Island. W. F. to fill a vacancy occasioned by the death of Col. J. W. Ely who was duly Elected at the last General Election held in July 1857 and that the Clerk forthwith notify the Governor of said appointment and also notify said S. Edlow so that he may qualify according to Law and proceed in the duties of said office.

Election Allowances

Ordered by the Board that J. B. Powers John Alexander and Eli Mathaway be and they are hereby allowed the sum of Three Dollars each for services rendered as Judges of Election at the General Election held on the 13th day of July A.D. 1857. out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Ordered by the Board that Humphrey Hill and William Aylmer be and they are hereby allowed the sum of Three Dollars each for services rendered as Clerks of Election out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Ordered by the Board that J. B. Powers W. J. Ely and F. W. Cramm be and they are hereby allowed the sum of Three Dollars each for the days services as Clerks of Election out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Ordered by the Board that F. W. Cramm County Auditor be and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$31.73 1/2 for services and supplies rendered Island County from June session to Sept session and a further sum of 50¢ for settlement of his age, out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.
