Jacob Eby the sum of \$3.00 for this  
day services and mileage, to be paid out of any money remaining in the treasury  
not otherwise appropriated

Ordered by the board that R. P. Hathaway  
be and hereby is allowed the sum of  
\$3.00 for this day services as Clerk Pro Tem  
of the Board out of any money remaining  
in the treasury not otherwise appropriated

Therefore the Court adjourned until the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March
