Ordered by the Board that Jacob B. Homibough Sheriff of Island County be and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$22.70 for services rendered at the U. S. Court Sept Term A.D. 1857 out of any moneys remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated also a further sum of \$33.00 for 11 days attendance on the Dist Court Ely Term A.D. 1858 out of any moneys remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated

Ordered by the Board that J. Crammy be and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$20.65 for services and supplies from Sept session at March session out of any moneys remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated

Pomeroy and Jacob Ely be and they are hereby allowed the sum of \$12.00 each for the days attendance as Commissioners and further sum of \$2.00 mileage to to Capt Miller was 22 1/2 cents to J. B. Pomeroy and 30 cents to Jacob Ely to wit: Capt Miller \$5.00 Mile, J. B. Pomeroy \$2.25 and Jacob Ely \$3.30, out of any moneys remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated

Allowance to Clerk

Ordered by the Board that J. Crammy County Auditor be and he is hereby allowed the sum of \$3.00 for the day attendance as clerk and \$1.00 for moneys for words out of any moneys remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated
