

Records of the County Commission

Monday Sept 6 1858

The Board of County Commissioners & Judges Court, H. V. met at Concord according to law on Monday the 6<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1858. Present - Calat Miller and Isaac B. Jones and B. J. Hathaway County Auditor Geo. Jew

The Prayer of G. W. Allen was received for a private way, from his premises to the road leading through Coff. Harbour and also for the Board to appoint reviewers to report & receive the property of said private way.

Ordered by the Board that John Kimball, John & David and Robt. G. Hill be and hereby are appointed reviewers for the locating, laying out and locate a private road leading from the premises of G. W. Allen to the public road from back Harbour to Lewis Cove, and to assess the dam and sustainment thereof; said road to be thirty feet in width, leading from some certain point on the premises of G. W. Allen to some certain point on the public road aforesaid.

Commissioned Court of the County of York, N.H. September 1858

Next day Continued Sept 6 1858

That the above named review proceed to view and locate said road according to the order of the Board of County Commissioners on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Oct 1858.

Ordered by the Board that the review appointed as by previous order of the Board of County Commissioners of York County, shall give at a three days notice to all persons whose lands cross private road, shall be located.

Ordered by the Board that the County Auditor Geo. Jew, receive an order directing the above named review to meet on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Oct 1858 view and locate said road according to application.

Ordered by the Board that G. W. Miller Sheriff be and he is hereby allowed the sum of Twenty One Dollars (\$21.00) for 7 days attendance at the next term of the Dist. Court, out of any moneys remaining in the Treasury and otherwise appropriated.
