Bailey of East Haver precinct be and they are hereby allowed the sum of 300 each for services rendered as Judges of Election held on the 12th day of July AD 1858 out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Miller of East Haver precinct be and they are hereby allowed the sum of 300 each for services rendered as Clerks of Election held on the 12th day of July AD 1858 out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Ordered by the Board

That Caleb Miller and J. B. Power be and they are hereby allowed the sum of Three Dollars each for this day services as County Commissioners and a further sum of Two Dollars to C. Miller and Three cents to J. B. Power as mileage: do not to Miller for out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Ordered by the Board that H. S. Hathaway be and he is hereby allowed the sum of Three Dollars for this day services as Clerk of the Term and a further sum of 125 for records 539 words. Total allowance \$4.37 out of any money remaining in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.
