in the Court fund not otherwise appropriated.

Ordered by the Board that R. S. Daily
be and he is hereby allowed the sum
of 15.00 and the sum of 14.00 for
attendance, mileage and services as witness
out of any money remaining in the treasury of
the Court, and not otherwise appropriated.
